

## **CONDITIONS OF DAY SOCIETY BOOKING AND PLAY**

- 1. Booking form must be returned, fully completed, within 14 days of a provisional booking made by telephone or email. A refundable deposit of £100 per society is required when returning booking form. Remainder of deposit is required no later than 10 days prior to the date of play. (see condition 3)**
- 2. A minimum number of 12 players is required to qualify for Society rates - if your party numbers fall below 12, normal visitor green fees & food tariffs will apply.**
- 3. Numbers & updated menu choices must be advised at least 10 days prior to the date of play. Remainder of deposit is also required at this point, which is equal to £10 per person. (deposit is now non-refundable)**
- 4. Final numbers must be given 48 hours before date of play (this is the minimum number that you will be charged for on the day.**
- 5. Organisers/Treasurers are requested to report to the Course Managers Office on arrival. Full payment will be required on the day of play.**
- 6. Handicap certificates are not required, but all players are expected to be of a reasonable standard and to respect the Course, Rules and Etiquette of the game. Please see website for a copy of our Course Rules & Etiquette.**
- 7. The Director, Course Manager & Head Green Keeper at Rutland County Golf Club, reserve the right to require any player not conforming to these conditions to leave the Course.**
- 8. All players must keep to their tee times and to avoid slow play please keep up with the group ahead. Please clear the green as soon as the result of the hole is determined (i.e. mark scorecard at the next tee not on the green).**
- 9. Society play is allowed from the yellow tee markers only (red for ladies).**
- 10. All players must observe the Course and Clubhouse dress code at all times.

- 12. HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS - If the Management believes that there is a risk of a lightning strike, three short klaxon blasts will be sounded. Players must leave the course and report to the Course Managers Office immediately. However any player who believes there is a danger from lightning, should discontinue play. It is the responsibility of the Society Organiser to ensure all players in his party leave the Course if he believes conditions have become dangerous.**
- 13. Shotgun and Two-Tee Starts may be available for groups of 60 plus. When a Shotgun or Two-Tee Start is booked, 60 will be the minimum number of green fees and catering tariffs charged for, if numbers drop on the day. If numbers drop to below 50 a shotgun or two-tee start will not be allowed.**
- 14. Society Organisers should ensure that members of their Society have adequate insurance cover.**
